1 Never miss a drop

Telemetry and fuel monitoring systems will send an alert with any sudden drop in fuel levels caused by theft or spillages.

2 Lights, camera, action

Keep tanks in a well-lit area and consider installing CCTV to deter thieves. Don't be tempted to block off the tank with plants or fencing as this can make it impossible or even dangerous for fuel to be delivered.

3 Upgrade and maintain

Opt for a close shackle padlock or a tank with in-built locking mechanisms to protect against theft and make sure your tank is regularly checked for cracks or overgrowing foliage.

4 Sound the alarm

Diesel tanks can be fitted with alarms for as little as £100 to scare off thieves. There are also a range of locks, FOBs and key codes to provide additional protection.

5 Protect vehicles and machinery

Vehicles and machinery can be an easy target. Opt for machinery and equipment with float-valves, which allows fuel to go in but not out.
