#### **BULK FUELS**

We offer a diverse range of bulk fuels, including road and red diesel as well as gas oil for heating and power generation – delivered on time and in full. This includes:

- Diesel/DERV
- Gas oil/Red diesel including Class D, A2, BS EN 590, Marine
- Kerosene and premium kerosene
- Industrial heating oil (Therma35)
- Cleaner burning alternative fuels Shell GTL Fuel & HVO
- Fuel oils (HFO, MFO, LFO)



#### **CLEANER BURNING FUELS**

Investing in alternative liquid fuels is a priority for Certas Energy, as we continue to develop and source solutions that help our customers to manage their journey to net zero 2050 and beyond. We offer drop-in diesel alternatives that can be used as direct replacements for conventional diesel fuels, with no equipment modifications required for an instant reduction of harmful emissions.

#### **FAME-FREE FUEL SOLUTIONS**

FAME stands for 'fatty acid methyl esters', a type of biodiesel derived from recycled cooking oil. It has been blended into DERV and gas oil more frequently since the UK's RTFO (Renewable Transport Fuel Obligation) came into effect, mandating a certain percentage of renewable content in fuel. While this is great news for the environment, FAME-heavy fuel comes with unique handling challenges, thanks to its hygroscopic qualities. We work with our customers to help find solutions for staying compliant, while reducing or avoiding FAME issues entirely.



#### HVC

Hydrotreated Vegetable Oil (HVO) offers a cleaner way to fuel commercial fleets across a range of sectors, both on- and off-road. Manufactured from 100% renewable and sustainable waste, HVO is a paraffinic drop-in replacement for diesel that meets EN15940 standards. FAME-, sulphur- and fossil-free, it is made using sustainably sourced vegetable fats and oils. Unlike conventional biodiesel, hydrogen (rather than methanol) is used as a catalyst, which makes HVO cleaner burning and ensures a long shelf life.



#### **SHELL GTL FUEL**



Suitable for commercial, construction, transport, marine, and public sector businesses, FAME-free Gas-to-Liquid (GTL) fuel by Shell significantly improves air quality by burning cleaner and producing fewer harmful emissions. Available to order through Certas Energy, throughout the UK, our GTL technology lowers local emissions of regulated pollutants: Particulate Matter (PM), Nitrogen Oxide (NOx), Carbon Monoxide (CO) and Hydrocarbons.



# INDUSTRIAL HEATING OIL & KEROSENE

Industrial heating oil – available through Certas Energy under the brand name Therma35 – is a highly cost-efficient drop-in alternative to conventional Ultra Low Sulphur Class A2 gas oil/red diesel. Industrial heating oil can be used for any heating purposes where gas oil would otherwise be used, without any modifications to equipment or machinery. Its uses include:

- Space heating and central heating
- Drying and industrial heating; for example in an agricultural context.
- Industrial boiler plant; powering various heat-related treatments that are required at food and beverage manufacture facilities

Kerosene is another alternative available for heating purposes: it is a low viscosity oil that has a range of commercial uses, and is particularly popular in the aviation sector, as well as on farms and for domestic heating.

Therma35 and kerosene are both readily available as part of an extensive portfolio of fuels, lubricants, additives and heating oils – everything you need to keep your business moving, the right way. As the UK's largest fuel distributor, Certas Energy has the unrivalled infrastructure to deliver regular supply of high-quality industrial heating oil in large quantities, serving customers across sectors and throughout the whole UK.

If your machinery's engines are fitted with SCR catalysts, AdBlue® is a simple, effective and efficient way to reduce harmful emissions. It meets the standards for Euro 5 and Euro 6 and can lower engine operating costs. Our AdBlue® is ISO 22241 compliant and available in a variety of packs including jerry cans, IBCs and bulk. AdBlue® is available nationwide across the Certas Energy HGV refuelling network.



# BULK FUEL AND LUBRICANTS STORAGE TANKS

From tank size, shape and material to dispensing options and management, whatever you need, it's all covered. A full range of storage solutions is available with capacities from 950 to 62,000 litres (or larger as a bespoke option); all are 110% integrally bunded to comply with oil storage regulations. Ensuring the process is as easy as possible, customers can opt for supply only or supply, installation and maintenance options. This includes assistance with contract lift on-site and removal of existing tanks as well as full technical and after sales support. Equipment can be purchased upfront or leased with flexible payment plans offered to make sure costs can be managed easily.

#### **TELEMETRY FOR FUEL TANKS**

FuelWise telemetry from Certas Energy is a smart monitoring system for fuel tanks, which enables complete visibility of how much fuel is being used and how much is still available in-tank.

FuelWise can be fitted wirelessly to your bulk fuel storage tanks, enabling remote fuel monitoring across wide-ranging sites. As such, it provides 'always-on' reporting in real time via the FuelWise mobile app. This level of visibility makes it clear when stocks are running low, so you can stay one step ahead by re-ordering fuel before it runs out, in just a few simple clicks.

The increased transparency created by FuelWise offers additional benefits, such as a side-by-side view of all liquid stock levels. Users can compare levels of fuel, lubricants, waste oil and more, across multiple tanks, so you not only know which fuels are running low, but also see where there may be an imbalance – for example, a surplus of road diesel compared to a shortage of a complementary product such as AdBlue. For total peace of mind, you will also receive alerts for sudden drops in stock levels via the app, which may be the first sign of theft or a leak.





#### **FUEL CARDS**

Fuel cards make it easier to manage your fleet, no matter the size. Drivers can pay for fuel using a company-issued fuel card instead of having to deal with company credit cards or lengthy expenses processes. Businesses can also keep track of fuel consumption, offering added payment security and reducing the risk of fraud or misuse.

The Certas Energy fuel card is accepted at over 3,000 refuelling sites across the UK, including all main motorway refuelling locations, as well as a large number of supermarkets. Network partners include Keyfuels, UK Fuels and Esso, supporting cross-acceptance.






#### **HGV REFUELLING SITES**

Certas Energy's 28 (and growing) HGV refuelling sites nationwide have been specially developed to allow ease and speed of filling and movement for larger vehicles.

Those who operate LCV, HGV or large fleets may prefer to fill up at these strategically located refuelling sites. Each location is fitted with high-speed pumps, which drastically reduces the time spent refuelling during journeys.

Certas Energy fuel card customers are entitled to discounts on all diesel purchases when refuelling at any of our refuelling sites. Additionally, at many sites AdBlue® and gas oil is available at fixed prices, so customers are not affected by external market fluctuations.




#### **RISK MANAGEMENT & HEDGING**

Hedging is a model used by larger Certas Energy customers who see constant demand and need to reduce their risk of the fluctuations in pricing in the fuel market. Customers who need over 100,000 litres of fuel per month can benefit from advantages such as a fixed pricing agreement, where customers fix a pence per litre based on a volume commitment per month, or capped pricing, whereby a customer pays a capped premium to ensure a ceiling price on fuel.
