






BULK FUELS

We offer a diverse range of bulk fuels, for off and on-road vehicles and for heating and power generation. This includes:

- Alternative fuels GTL Fuel and HVO

CLEANER ALTERNATIVES TO DIESEL - HVO

Hydrotreated Vegetable Oil (HVO) is a drop-in alternative diesel that offers a seamless solution for on-road and off-road commercial fleets.

Responsibly sourced, HVO is a 100% biodegradable renewable diesel. Certas Energy HVO reduces life-cycle green house gas (GHG) emissions by up to 90% compared to standard diesel, helping businesses to reduce their carbon footprint with immediate effect. Practically FAME and fossil free* fuel meets EN15940 standards and offers excellent low-temperature performance, higher filterability and improved combustion properties.

Unlike conventional biofuel, hydrogen (rather than methanol) is used as a catalyst, which makes HVO cleaner burning than standard diesel and ensures a long shelf life.

DID YOU KNOW?



Certas Energy's trial of HVO for its own fleet delivered savings of 6,433 tonnes of CO2e over a two-year period. As well as fuelling our own tanker fleets with HVO and offering nationwide delivery of the alternative fuel, Certas Energy was also the first UK distributor to offer HVO to HGV fuel card users at the pump. It is now available at selected HGV sites and the number continues to grow.

Certas Energy has strengthened its position as a transparent and trusted energy transition partner for transport businesses after becoming a **Recognised Fuel Supplier** under the Renewable Fuels Assurance Scheme (RFAS).

TRANSITION TO ALTERNATIVES, YOUR WAY

Fully committing to a transition to HVO or GTL Fuel can seem like a big move for some businesses, but solutions are available to facilitate a more gradual transition.

As HVO and GTL Fuel are drop-in fuels and can be used interchangeably with DERV, split deliveries of the alternatives and conventional diesel can be arranged. This helps to reduce the impact on fuel cost forecasting while taking steps to reduce your operational carbon footprint.

ALTERNATIVE FUELS

Investing in alternative fuels is a priority for Certas Energy, as we continue to develop and source solutions that help our customers transition to net zero 2050. We offer drop-in diesel alternatives that are direct replacements for conventional fuels such as DERV, with no equipment modifications required, for an instant reduction of harmful emissions.

GTL FUEL

GTL Fuel is a cleaner, quieter, and longer lasting drop-in alternative to standard diesel that offers a number of performance and operational benefits. As it is free from Fatty Acid Methyl Ester (FAME), a biofuel that can cause water contamination, diesel bugs, premature fuel ageing and instability (separation) in long term storage, using GTL Fuel can help reduce downtime and costs due to fewer filter changes.

It has a naturally high cetane number, so when compared with standard diesel, the combustion process is more complete, leading to a cleaner burn, a reduction in harmful local emissions (such as nitrogen oxide NOx and particulate matter PM), excellent cold weather handling and much improved cold start performance.

It also has a long-shelf life and can reduce engine noise by 1-4 Db. Virtually free from sulphur, metals and aromatics, GTL Fuel is non-toxic, less harmful to the environment and is also much safer to handle and store.



INDUSTRIAL HEATING OIL AND KEROSENE

Industrial heating oil – available through Certas Energy under the brand name Therma35 – is a highly cost-efficient and compliant drop-in alternative to conventional Class A2 gas oil/red diesel.

Therma35 can be used for any heating purposes, including commercial boilers, heaters, driers and furnaces, without any modifications to equipment or machinery.

Benefits include:

- No waxing
- FAME-free
- Safe to store all year round

Kerosene - often referred to as the traditional heating oil choice. It is a low viscosity oil ideal for a range of commercial uses.

Kerosene, or 28 second oil as it is commonly known, is a popular choice for industries where engines and machinery are exposed to colder temperatures, due to its low freezing point. **Premium kerosene** is an enhanced kerosene product, containing additives to boost fuel performance, prolong shelf-life and improve fuel efficiency.

It meets the standards for Euro 5 and Euro 6 and can lower engine operating costs. Our AdBlue® is ISO 22241 compliant and available in a variety of packs including jerry cans, IBCs and bulk. AdBlue® is available nationwide across the Certas Energy HGV refuelling network.




BULK FUEL AND LUBRICANTS STORAGE TANKS

With our comprehensive range of robust, high-performance storage, dispensing and monitoring products and services, you can ensure your requirements are covered when it comes to keeping fuel and lubricants safe and secure.

We offer a full range of storage solutions with capacities from 950 to 62,000 litres (or larger as a bespoke option). Our 110% integrally bunded tanks are designed to meet or exceed local environmental guidelines, fuel storage standards and manufacturing regulations.

Ensuring the process is as easy as possible, customers can opt for supply only or supply, installation and maintenance options. This includes assistance with contract lift on-site and removal of existing tanks as well as full technical and after sales support. Equipment can be purchased upfront or leased, with flexible payment plans.







TELEMETRY FOR FUEL TANKS

FuelWise telemetry from Certas Energy is a smart monitoring system for fuel tanks, which enables complete visibility of how much fuel is being used and how much is still available in-tank.

The system can be fitted wirelessly to bulk fuel storage tanks, enabling remote, real-time fuel monitoring via the FuelWise mobile app.

This increased transparency helps businesses to keep track of fuel levels, and offers a side-by-side view of all liquid stock levels. For total peace of mind, users receive alerts for sudden drops in stock levels via the app, which may be the first sign of theft or a leak.

Manual reorders can be made via the app, or automatic top-ups arranged, so you never run out of fuel.







ROADSIDE SERVICES

TheStop at The Hollies is the first truck stop operated by Certas Energy's Roadside Services division. Following major investment, the UK's oldest truck stop now boasts a café, bar, 15-room hotel, washroom facilities, gaming area, laundrette, truck wash and HGV refuelling bunker. It also offers improved parking facilities, with 230 secure HGV parking spaces per night, as well as on-site security guards and CCTV monitoring.

TheStop network is being developed with drivers' safety, security and and comfort in mind.

HGV REFUELLING SITES

Certas Energy's 26 (and growing) HGV refuelling sites nationwide have been specially developed to allow ease and speed of filling and movement for coaches, LCV and HGVs.

The sites offer competitively priced fuels and additives, including Diesel, GTL Fuel, HVO and AdBlue®.

Each location is fitted with high-speed pumps which fill multiple vehicles at 120 litres per minute, so drivers don't lose valuable time. Our high-speed HGV refuelling sites accept a range of fuel cards, including Keyfuels, UK Fuels, AS24 and Morgan Fuels. In addition, Certas Energy fuel card customers can also benefit from discounts off certain purchases, including diesel and AdBlue®.



ONBOARD TELEMATICS

FuelTrace™ is Certas Energy's own integrated onboard telematics solution. By tracking vehicle and driver performance, it provides fleet managers with full visibility of vehicle activity and identifies opportunities to reduce costs, improve driver safety and minimise admin. FuelTrace™ is available as a standalone solution but can also be used in conjunction with Certas Energy Fuel Card data for a full view of fleet fuel expenditure and the most accurate MPG measurements on the market.

CarbonTrace™ is an emissions monitoring system that that makes it easier to track the carbon footprint of fuel purchased with Certas Energy fuel cards. The technology tracks the volume of fuel purchased and automatically calculates the amount of carbon dioxide, nitrogen oxides and greenhouse gases that are produced by burning the fuel.

Our Certas Energy Fuel Card is an ideal solution for fleet managers to oversee fleet fuel spend and ensure consistent access to high-quality fuel that maximises output and efficiency. Businesses can also benefit from added payment security and minimised risk of fraud or misuse. The Certas Energy fuel card is accepted at over 3,600 refuelling sites across the UK, including all main motorway refuelling locations, as well as at many supermarkets. Network partners include Keyfuels, UK Fuels and Esso, supporting cross-acceptance.

FuelTapp is the UK's first digital fuel card, from Certas Energy. It allows users to pay for fuel at Certas Energy bunker sites using an app-generated PIN.

FuelTapp's theft-proof digital design eliminates the need for physical cards or cash, helping to minimise the admin burden of managing lost or damaged cards, terminal bad reads and forgotten pin numbers.

agreements, with a fixed monthly pence
per litre based on a volume commitment
per month, or capped pricing, whereby a
customer pays a capped premium to ensure
a ceiling price on fuel. Prices are based on
the live fuel market with indicative prices
available.



We have also been awarded 4 stars by The ECO Stars Fleet Recognition Scheme for our dedication and drive to be an environmentally responsible fleet operator.

The scheme rates members for their operational and environmental performance and offers ways to further improve fuel efficiency and air quality. Following assessment of our 143-strong mixed fleet in Scotland, which includes HGVs, we were awarded an overall operational rating of 4 stars – the highest achievement for a new member with diesel-powered vehicles.



FIRST TO OFFER HVO FUEL AT HGV REFUELLING SITES

The roll-out of HVO across our extensive network underpins our commitment to supporting UK businesses on their transition journey to net zero.

We have significantly invested in our national infrastructure (depot network) to grow our supply of HVO in the UK. In 2022, we converted 13 strategically located depots to stock and supply HVO supported by 6 new terminal supply locations and 6 bunker sites. Further conversion works are scheduled throughout 2023 and 2024 to build a national supply network as demand grows.

FUTURE READY FUELS PROJECT



Combining HVO with renewable tech solutions such as hybrid air source heat pump systems or solar PV systems offers hard-to-decarbonise properties the option to take the first step on their net zero journey.
